NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL -- In accordance with Article 21 of the Convention of 13 July 1931 for Limiting the  
Manufacture and Regulating the Distribution of Narcotic Drugs, as amended by the Protocol of 11 December 1946, the Secretary-  
General has the honour to communicate the following legislative text.

Federal Government Notice No. 34 of 1955.

[ACT 50/52 (Southern Rhodesia)]

Application of Section 29 of the Pharmacy, Poisons  
and Dangerous Drugs Act

It is hereby notified that the Federal Minister of  
Health, being satisfied that the products specified in  
the Schedule are of medical value, has, in terms of

section 29 of the Pharmacy, Poisons and Dangerous  
Drugs Act, 1952, of Southern Rhodesia, as amended  
and adapted, declared that section 29 of the said  
Act shall cease to apply to such products.

#### SCHEDULE

Methyldesomorphine (6-Methyl- $\Delta^6$ -Desoxymor-  
phine); Diacetyl-N-allylnormorphine.
