DANGEROUS DRUGS

The Misuse of Drugs Act 1971 (Commencement No. 1) Order 1971

20 December 1971

In pursuance of section 40(3) of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1971, <u>1</u>/ I hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Misuse of Drugs Act 1971 (Commencement No. 1) Order 1971.

2. Sections 1, 32, 35, 37, 38 and 40 of and Schedule 1 to the Misuse of Drugs Act 1971 shall come into operation on 1 February 1972.
