Report of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006) prepared in accordance with paragraph 6 of resolution 2375 (2017)

On 11 September 2017, the Security Council, by its resolution 2375 (2017), decided to apply the measures imposed by it in paragraph 6 of resolution 2371 (2017) on vessels transporting prohibited items from the Democratic People's Republic of Korea, and directed the Committee to designate these vessels and to report to the Council within 15 days of the adoption of resolution 2375 (2017).

In order to fulfil these tasks, the Committee considered a list of vessels for designation in accordance with paragraph 6 of resolution 2375 (2017).

On 3 October 2017, the Committee acted in line with the Security Council's directive and approved the following list of vessels for designation:

- 1. PETREL 8, IMO: 9562233, MMSI: 620233000
- 2. HAO FAN 6, IMO: 8628597, MMSI: 341985000
- 3. TONG SAN 2, IMO: 8937675, MMSI: 445539000
- 4. JIE SHUN, IMO: 8518780, MMSI: 514569000
