It also notes the unpublished records of meetings and sound recordings deposited in the Archives of the United Nations and the press releases concerning the meetings.

Part 6J of the Check List of United Nations Documents comprises the documents of the Population Commission, one of the Functional Commissions of the Economic and Social Council. The present number lists all documents issued during the period 1946 to 1949. Documents issued after the beginning of 1950 are listed in the current issues of the monthly United Nations Documents Index.

## EXPLANATION

**ENTRY NUMBER.** Documents and introductory notes are referred to by entry numbers in the index to this check list. Entry numbers do not appear on the documents and should not be used in citations.

**LANGUAGE OF ISSUE.** The language editions in which a document is issued are indicated as English (E), French (F), Spanish (S), Russian (R), Chinese (C), or bilingual English-French (E&F) texts.

**DOCUMENT SYMBOL AND SHORT TITLE.** This number should be used in citing documents. In the case of publications without document symbol numbers, titles should be cited together with the session number, issue number, supplement number, and volume number, whichever is included in the entry. Title entries have been standardized and shortened or expanded in order to clarify the meaning of the titles and the authorship of the documents, so the entries do not always conform literally to the actual documentary titles. The collation shows the pagination of the English or bilingual English-French text only. The date appearing on each document below the document symbol number is usually the date of registration of the documentary text with the Bureau of Documents for publication and translation and should be the same in all language texts. The date of registration closes each entry. Corrigenda and addenda are usually grouped with the parent document in the same entry. Corrigenda are corrections of errors in the text, title, date and classification of documents,

emendations of the translation, and additions of omitted text. Addenda include supplementary material, such as annexes, tables, and other additional communications. Revisions are texts revised through formal amendment, or new editions prepared by the submitting delegation or by the Secretariat.

**REPUBLICATION NOTES** indicate the republication of whole documents in other documents or in the Official Records.

**RESTRICTED** Documents of "restricted distribution" are indicated in this Check List by a black dot (●) before the symbol.

**INTRODUCTORY NOTES** give a short parliamentary history of the Commission and describe briefly each Committee session by session, including the date of its appointment, citing its terms of reference, naming its members and officers, listing its reports and documents series symbol (if any), and tabulating its meeting records. The plenary meetings are shown in tables for each session. The tables indicate both published and unpublished meeting records and related press releases. Since drafts for the published meeting records should be deposited as a matter of course in the Archives of the United Nations, the tables show under the heading "Archives" only the unpublished manuscript records deposited in the Archives ("TPV"; "TSR") and the sound recordings ("X").

The Population Commission, one of the Functional Commissions of the Economic and Social Council, was established by Economic and Social Council resolution 3(III), adopted on 3 October 1946. The Population Commission is composed of one representative of each of the twelve nominating State Members of the United Nations, selected by the Council. In order to maintain close liaison with other bodies concerned with population problems, the Population Commission shall invite representatives from the Economic and Employment Commission, the Statistical Commission and the Social Commission, as well as representatives of the World Health Organization. Except for the initial period, the term of office of the members of the Commission shall be for three years. For the initial period one-third of the members were elected to serve for two years, one-third for three years and one-third for four years, the term of each member to be determined by lot. Retiring members are eligible for re-election. Accordingly the Council at its 46th plenary meeting, on 2 October 1946, elected the twelve nominating States. The terms of office were determined by lot at the 47th meeting on 3 October 1946, as follows: to serve for two years: China, the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, the United Kingdom, the United States of America; for three years: Australia, Canada, France, the Ukrainian Soviet Socialist Republic; for four years: Brazil, the Netherlands, Peru, Yugoslavia (See document E/223, Check List Part 5: No. 1, entry 520). In order to secure a balanced expert representation in the various fields covered by the Commission, the Secretary-General was instructed to consult with the Governments in question before they made their final nominations. The nominations have to be confirmed by the Council. Accordingly the Council, at a special meeting on 10 December 1946, confirmed the nominations submitted by the Secretary-General (Documents E/250 and /Add.2, E/252, E/427, Check List Part 5: No. 1, entries 549, 624).

At its 202nd and 206th meetings, on 17 and 19 April 1948, the Council filled the vacancies caused by the expiration of the terms of office of the first third of the membership, initially appointed for two years, by electing China, the United Kingdom, the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, and the United States of America, for a term of three years (See document E/988). The representatives nominated or renominated by the elected States were confirmed by the Council at its 225th meeting on 29 August 1948 and its 272nd meeting on 11 March 1949. (See documents E/987/Add.1 and 3, E/1235 and E/1308). A replacement for Australia was confirmed at the 272nd meeting on 11 March 1949, (See document E/1235).

At its 315th meeting on 1 August 1949 the Council replaced the second third of the representatives whose term of office was to expire by the end of 1949, electing France, Sweden, Syria and the Ukrainian Soviet Socialist Republic (See document E/1508).
