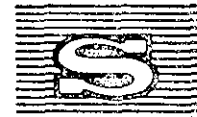

NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

At its 81st meeting on 13 December 1978, the General Assembly adopted resolution 33/39,* entitled "Question of East Timor". In paragraph 4 of that resolution, the General Assembly

"Draws the attention of the Security Council, in conformity with Article 11, paragraph 3, of the Charter of the United Nations, to the critical situation in the Territory of East Timor and recommends that it take all effective steps for the implementation of its resolutions 384 (1975) and 389 (1976) with a view to securing the full exercise by the people of East Timor of their right to self-determination and independence".
