Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 45th meeting, on 4 December 1980, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/35/66) on the administrative and financial implications of draft resolutions III A and B, recommended by the Second Committee in paragraph 40 of its report (A/35/592/Add.3), as well as the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions (A/35/7/Add.20).
2. The statements and observations made during the Committee's consideration of this question are reflected in the summary record of the meeting (A/C.5/35/SR.45).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without objection, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolutions III A and B recommended by the Second Committee in paragraph 40 of its report (A/35/592/Add.3), additional appropriations of \$93,900 would be required under section 17 of the programme budget for the biennium 1980-1981. In addition, an amount of \$15,000 for staff assessment would have to be appropriated under section 31, to be offset by an equivalent amount under income section 1 (Income from staff assessment).
4. Statements in explanation of position were made by the representatives of the Federal Republic of Germany, the United States of America and the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics.
