Report of the Fifth Committee

- 1. At its 45th meeting, on 4 December 1980, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/35/66) on the administrative and financial implications of draft resolutions III A and B, recommended by the Second Committee in paragraph 40 of its report (A/35/592/Add.3), as well as the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions (A/35/7/Add.20).
- 2. The statements and observations made during the Committee's consideration of this question are reflected in the summary record of the meeting (A/C.5/35/SR.45).

## DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

- 3. The Fifth Committee decided, without objection, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolutions III A and B recommended by the Second Committee in paragraph 40 of its report (A/35/592/Add.3), additional appropriations of \$93,900 would be required under section 17 of the programme budget for the biennium 1980-1981. In addition, an amount of \$15,000 for staff assessment would have to be appropriated under section 31, to be offset by an equivalent amount under income section 1 (Income from staff assessment).
- 4. Statements in explanation of position were made by the representatives of the Federal Republic of Germany, the United States of America and the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics.
