Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 32nd meeting, on 19 November 1980, the Fifth Committee considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/35/50) on the administrative and financial implications of the draft resolution recommended by the Third Committee (A/35/638, para. 10). The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were expressed orally by its Chairman.
2. The statements and observations made during the Committee's consideration of this question are reflected in the summary record of the meeting (A/C.5/35/SR.32).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided without objection to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt the draft resolution recommended by the Third Committee (A/35/638, para. 10), additional appropriations of \$37,000 would be required under the programme budget for the biennium 1980-1981, to be distributed as follows:

Under section 6 - \$35,000

Under section 8 - \$ 2,000

The necessary conference servicing requirements for the proposed third session of the Advisory Committee for the International Year of Disabled Persons, which should not exceed \$136,000, would be considered in the context of the consolidated statement of conference servicing costs which will be submitted to the General Assembly towards the end of the present session.
