**New Delhi, the 24th October, 1994**

S.O. 763(E).—Whereas the Central Government is satisfied on the basis of available information to the possible use of N-Acetylanthranilic Acid in the production or manufacture of methaqualone, and also to implement the provisions of the United Nations Convention Against Illicit Trafficking in Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances, 1988.

Now, therefore, the Central Government in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-clause (vii a) of Section 2 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (61 of 1985) hereby declares N-Acetylanthranilic Acid as a controlled substance for the purpose of the said Sub-Clause.

NOTIFICATION

S.O.39(E). Whereas the Central Government is satisfied, on the basis of information and evidence which has become available to it with respect to the nature and effect of, and the abuse or the scope for abuse of, any substance (natural or synthetic) or natural material or any salt or preparation of such substance or material; and the modifications which have been made with respect to such substance natural material or salt or preparation of such substance or material in the International Convention referred to in sub-clause (c) of clause(ix) of section 2 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (61 of 1985)<sup>1/</sup> (hereinafter referred to as the said Act), that it is necessary or expedient to add the following substances or natural material or salt or preparation of such substance or material in the list of psychotropic substance specified in the Schedule to the said Act;

Now, therefore in exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby makes the following additions in the list of psychotropic substance specified in the Schedule to the said Act, namely :-

In the Schedule of the said Act, after serial number 105 and entries relating thereto, the following serial numbers and entries relating thereto shall be added, namely :-

NOTIFICATION

G.S.R. <sup>25(E)</sup>In exercise of the powers conferred by section 9, read with section 76, of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (61 of 1985)<sup>1/</sup> the Central Government hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Rules, 1985, namely :-

1. (1) These rules may be called the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (Amendment) Rules, 1996.

(2) These rules shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Rules, 1985<sup>2/</sup> in Schedule I, under sub-heading II relating to psychotropic substances, after serial number 33 and entries relating thereto, the following serial numbers and entries shall be added, namely:-
