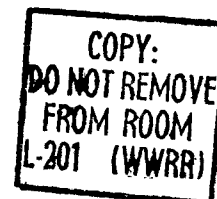

The meeting was called to order at 10.45 a.m.

ELECTION OF A VICE-CHAIRMAN

The CHAIRMAN said that the election would have to be postponed since the Committee was still not in a position to elect the other Vice-Chairman. He urged the regional groups concerned to submit a nomination as soon as possible.

ORGANIZATION OF WORK (A/SPC/36/L.1)

The CHAIRMAN drew the attention of the Committee on the Tentative Timetable for the Work of the Special Political Committee contained in document A/SPC/36/L.1. In drawing up the Committee's programme of work, account had been taken of the availability of documentation and the number of meetings allotted to the various items at previous sessions. The report of the Secretary-General on item 64 was contained in document A/36/85. The report of the Special Committee to investigate Israeli Practices on that item would be issued before the item was taken up. The reports of the Secretary-General on items 65 and 66 would be issued at a later date. No basic documentation was expected with regard to item 68.

He said that, if he heard no objection, he would take it that the Committee wished to adopt the programme of work contained in document A/SPC/36/L.1.

It was so decided.

The CHAIRMAN urged the members of the Committee to attend meetings punctually in order to expedite its work.
