Report of the Fifth Committee

- 1. At its fiftieth meeting, on 23 November 1981, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/36/48) on the administrative and financial implications of the draft resolution recommended by the Fourth Committee in paragraph 9 of its report (A/36/680). The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman.
- 2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/36/SR.50).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided by a recorded vote of 62 to 13, with 13 abstentions, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt the draft resolution recommended by the Fourth Committee in paragraph 9 of its report (A/36/680) an additional appropriation of \$19,000 would be required under

section 9 of the proposed programme budget for 1982-1983. The record of the vote is as follows: 1/

In favour:

Afghanistan, Algeria, Argentina, Bahamas, Bahrain, Bangladesh, Barbados, Brazil, Bulgaria, Burma, Burundi, Byelorussian Soviet Socialist Republic, Central African Republic, China, Congo, Cuba, Czechoslovakia, Democratic Yemen, Ecuador, Ethiopia, German Democratic Republic, Ghana, Guinea, Hungary, India, Indonesia, Iran, Ivory Coast, Jamaica, Jordan, Kuwait, Liberia, Libyan Arab Jamahiriya, Madagascar, Malaysia, Mozambique, Nepal, Niger, Oman, Panama, Philippines, Poland, Qatar, Romania, Saudi Arabia, Sri Lanka, Sudan, Suriname, Thailand, Togo, Trinidad and Tobago, Tunisia, Uganda, Ukrainian Soviet Socialist Republic, Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, United Arab Emirates, Venezuela, Viet Nam, Yugoslavia, Zaire, Zambia, Zimbabwe.

Against:

Australia, Belgium, Canada, France, Germany, Federal Republic of, Greece, Israel, Italy, Japan, Netherlands, Portugal, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, United States of America.

Abstaining:

Austria, Chile, Denmark, Finland, Ireland, New Zealand, Norway, Singapore, Spain, Sweden, Turkey, Upper Volta, Uruguay.

^{1/} The representatives of the following countries indicated subsequently that, had they been present during the voting, they would have voted in favour of the proposal: Benin, Congo, Egypt, Guyana, Kenya, Iraq, Mauritania, Morocco, Nigeria, Rwanda, Senegal, Sierra Leone, United Republic of Cameroon, United Republic of Tanzania and Upper Volta. The representative of Uruguay indicated that, through an error, his vote had been recorded as abstaining whereas it should have been in favour of the proposal.
