Article xx

Elements of crimes

- 1. Elements of crimes shall be formulated, interpreted and applied in a manner consistent with the terms of articles 5 <u>bis</u>, 5 <u>ter</u>, 5 <u>quater</u> and article 21, paragraph 2. They shall be applied by the Court in reaching determinations as to guilt.
- 2. Elements of crimes shall be adopted by the Preparatory Commission in accordance with its rules of procedure, and shall be an annex to this Statute.
- 3. Elements of crimes may be amended in accordance with the provisions of article 110 that concern amendments to articles 5 <u>bis</u>, 5 <u>ter</u> and 5 <u>quater</u>.
- 4. Elements of crimes shall be adopted before the Prosecutor commences an investigation.
