PETITION FROM SHEIK ABDURAMAN CONCERNING
SOMALILAND UNDER ITALIAN ADMINISTRATION

(Circulated in accordance with rule 85 and supplementary rules F and L
of the rules of procedure for the Trusteeship Council)

Nations Visiting Mission to Trust Territories in
East Africa.

To: The United Nations (Advisory) Council

I the undersigned, Sheik Abraham, son of Sheik Abdi Ogaden of the
Mohamed Zuber tribe, a Somali 49 years of age, born at Afmedo, and a resident
of Baidoa, wish to submit this request to you and to inform you that I am
the person who escaped from Ischia Baidoa, where on 31 March 1950 the following
were seized from me:

Ten camels valued at 1,500 somalos
Sixteen cows valued at 2,080 somalos
Fifty goats valued at 750 somalos
Net value.....3,450 somalos
Household articles..6,220 somalos
25 quintals of grain valued at 540 somalos
22 quintals of millet....660 somalos
32 water cans.....520 somalos
3 household Zaribas.....650 somalos
Men's and women's clothing...1,620 somalos
A pair of "ara per la archio"..500 somalos
2 silver "Heresi".....160 somalos
3 shambas valued at 3,000 somalos
2 licences.....150 somalos

The household articles mentioned above belonged to me and were seized on
31 March 1950 at Baidoa.

There are other persons here whose belongings have been seized:

6 cows valued at 900 somalos

10 quintals of millet....300 somalos

Household articles.....2,000 somalos

These articles were seized by the Italians in 1950. I request the return of these articles that the Italians seized.
