CABLEGRAM DATED 27 JULY 1950 FROM THE UNDER-SECRETARY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF COSTA RICA TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL IN REPLY TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL'S CABLEGRAM OF 14 JULY 1950 (S/1619) CONCERNING THE SECURITY COUNCIL RESOLUTIONS OF 25 AND 27 JUNE AND 7 JULY 1950 (S/1501, S/1511, S/1588)

WITH REFERENCE TO YOUR LAST CABLEGRAM, IN CONFORMITY WITH OUR OBLIGATIONS UNDER UNITED NATIONS CHARTER WE ARE PLACING AT THE DISPOSAL OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL ADEQUATE STORES IN OUR COUNTRY FOR AIR OR SEA BASES AND TROOP QUARTERS OR STATIONS. IN ADDITION WE OFFER TO SEND VOLUNTEERS FOR PRELIMINARY TRAINING IN THE UNITED STATES IN ORDER TO ENSURE THAT THEY WILL NOT RUN GREATER RISKS IF THEY ARE SENT TO THE FRONT, THAN THOSE LIABLE TO BE FACED BY PRACTISED TROOPS. FURTHERMORE WE WISH TO INFORM THE SECURITY COUNCIL THAT WE ARE PREPARING A DRAFT LAW TO BE PLACED BEFORE THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY WITH A VIEW TO INCREASING THE STRENGTH OF THE CIVIL GUARD IN ORDER TO GUARANTEE THE SECURITY OF NATIONAL TERRITORY AND AVOID ACTS OF SABOTAGE AND ANY OTHER UNFORESEEN CONTINGENCY.
