After paragraph 32 add a new paragraph reading

33. In connection with the upgrading of the P-4 post to the P-5 level in the Centre against Apartheid (para. 11 (a) above) should the General Assembly adopt the draft resolutions enumerated on page 1 of the Secretary-General's statement, an additional appropriation in the amount of \$11,200 would be required in section 3 for 1985. In addition, an amount of \$5,100 would be required for staff assessment in section 31, offset by an equivalent amount under income section 1.
