Administrative and financial implications of the draft resolution contained in document E/CN.4/L.1436

Statement submitted by the Secretary-General in accordance with rule 28 of the rules of procedure of the functional commissions of the Economic and Social Council

- 1. In operative paragraph 2 of draft resolution E/CN.4/L.1436, the Commission would request the Economic and Social Council to authorize the Chairman of the Sub-Commission to appoint a working group of five of its members to meet for not more than three working days in advance of the thirty-second session of the Sub-Commission.
- 2. On the above assumptions, the relevant costs are estimated as follows:

Conference and servicing costs (interpretation and sound engineer, English, French, Spanish)

Subsistence of five members of the Sub-Commission during three days in advance of the thirty-second session of the Sub-Commission
