Calendar of conferences and meetings

Adoption of the draft biennial calendar of conferences and meetings for 2010 and 2011

Note by the Secretariat

1. The present document contains the draft biennial calendar of conferences and meetings of the United Nations, which includes meetings of organs of the United Nations, their subsidiary bodies, special conferences and expert groups. Conferences and meetings of the main legislative and executive bodies of the specialized agencies, the International Atomic Energy Agency and treaty bodies established under the auspices of the United Nations are also listed for information.
2. After review by the Committee at its substantive session, the draft biennial calendar will be included in the report of the Committee to the General Assembly together with any updates and/or comments.
3. At its 698th meeting, on 1 July 2009, the Committee reviewed the provisional calendar of conferences and meetings in the economic, social and related fields for 2010 and 2011 (E/2009/L.10) and submitted its observations to the Economic and Social Council through a letter from the Chair of the Committee to the President of the Council (E/2009/108). The Council considered the provisional calendar at its 35th meeting, on 24 July 2009, and decided to approve it (decision 2009/218).
4. In considering the draft biennial calendar of conferences and meetings for 2010-2011, the Committee may wish to note the following meetings in particular (the programme budget implications of the meetings listed in subparagraphs 4 (f), (g), (h), (j) and (m) below could not be assessed at the time of adoption of the legislative mandates owing to lack of information):

2010

(a) Item 6, “Human Rights Council, high-level task force on the implementation of the right to development”, and item 29, “Human Rights Council, open-ended Working Group on the Right to Development”. The mandates of the task force and the Working Group will expire in 2010 and their mandates to meet in 2011 will be subject to renewal by the Human Rights Council in 2010;

(b) Item 36, “International Civil Service Commission, seventieth session”. In section I, paragraph 4 (g) of its resolution 40/243, the General Assembly reaffirmed that the Commission should hold its regular annual session at United Nations Headquarters and, if more than one session is required in any one year, may accept an invitation from one of its participating organizations to hold its other session or sessions at the headquarters of that particular organization. It is anticipated that the Commission will hold its spring 2010 session in Santiago so as to enable the members to familiarize themselves with conditions at other duty stations and to establish contacts with members of legislative bodies of other organizations;

(c) Items 98 and 147, “Investments Committee”. In July 2010, the Investments Committee will hold one meeting in London in conjunction with the fifty-seventh session of the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Board. According to an established tradition, a member of the Investments Committee hosts one of its meetings. In May 2010, the Investments Committee will meet in Beijing. All expenses pertaining to the conference servicing requirements are met by the host country at no cost to the United Nations;

(d) Item 99, “Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions”. By part II, paragraph 2 of its resolution 1437 (XIV), the General Assembly authorized the Advisory Committee, in fulfilment of its functions under rule 157 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, to meet as it deems necessary and appropriate at the various offices of the United Nations and at the headquarters of the specialized agencies in order to advise the agencies on administrative and financial matters. In practice, the Advisory Committee has continued to meet outside New York along the lines authorized by the Assembly. The Advisory Committee may hold meetings at various United Nations duty stations and agencies located outside New York during its spring 2010 session;

(e) Item 148, “United Nations Joint Staff Pension Board, fifty-seventh session” and item 149, “United Nations Joint Staff Pension Board Standing Committee”. The Regulations of the Pension Fund, as adopted by the General Assembly, do not establish any headquarters locations for the Pension Fund, the Pension Board, the Standing Committee of the Pension Board or the Committee of the Actuaries. Meetings of these entities are usually hosted by member organizations of the Pension Fund, not by Governments. In July 2010, the Board is expected to hold its annual session in London and the Standing Committee will meet with the members of the Board during the session;

(f) Item 179, “2010 high-level plenary meeting of the Assembly”. In paragraph 1 of its resolution 63/302, the General Assembly decided to convene in 2010, at the commencement of its sixty-fifth session, a high-level plenary meeting of the Assembly with the participation of Heads of State and Government. In paragraph 2, the Assembly decided to hold consultations on the scope, modalities, format and organization of the high-level plenary meeting with a view to concluding

consultations before the end of 2009 and requested the Secretary-General to submit a report to it at the beginning of its sixty-fourth session. In the absence of information on the duration and modalities of the high-level plenary meeting, it is the understanding of the Department of General Assembly and Conference Management that the meeting will be held during the sixty-fifth session of the Assembly and will require two meetings per day, one in the morning and one in the afternoon, using the meetings entitlements allocated to the Assembly. With regard to documentation, assuming that there will be one pre-session document not exceeding the page limit of 8,500 words and one outcome document of no more than 10,700 words, the work will be absorbed within the existing resources. Should the modalities exceed the above understanding, the matter will be reported to the Assembly in accordance with rule 153 of its rules of procedure;

(g) Item 182, “High-level review meeting on the follow-up to and implementation of the Mauritius Strategy for Further Implementation of the Programme of Action for the Sustainable Development of Small Island Developing States”. In paragraph 17 of its resolution 63/213, the General Assembly reaffirmed its decision to review, at its sixty-fifth session, the progress made in addressing the vulnerabilities of small island developing States through the implementation of the Mauritius Strategy for Implementation, and decided to convene a two-day high-level review in September 2010 as a part of that session. It is the understanding of the Department for General Assembly and Conference Management that the high-level review meeting will be held during the sixty-fifth session of the Assembly and will require two meetings per day, one in the morning and one in the afternoon, for a duration of two days, with conference resources to be provided from those allocated to the Assembly. However, if the modalities of the high-level review meeting exceed the above understanding, the matter will be reported to the Assembly in accordance with rule 153 of its rules of procedure;

(h) Item 298, “United Nations Appeals Tribunal” and item 299, “United Nations Dispute Tribunal”. The General Assembly decided, in resolution 61/261, to create a new system of internal justice. It articulated further specifics of this new system in resolutions 62/228 and 63/253, including adopting the statutes of the two Tribunals. The formal component of this new system is comprised of the United Nations Dispute Tribunal, a court of first instance, and the United Nations Appeals Tribunal, an appellate instance. The General Assembly determined that the United Nations Dispute Tribunal, as a court of first instance, shall sit on a full-time basis and issue binding judgements in writing and further determined that applicants should be permitted to file applications to these Tribunals in any of the six official languages of the United Nations. The Assembly also established the Office of Administration of Justice, which coordinates the work of the two Tribunals and the newly established Office of Staff Legal Assistance. The Office of Administration of Justice has been asked to report to the Assembly at its sixty-fifth session on the functioning of the new system. It is the understanding of the Department for General Assembly and Conference Management that the overall conference servicing requirements for the United Nations Dispute Tribunal, the United Nations Appeals Tribunal and the Office of Administration of Justice may exceed those allocated hitherto for the United Nations Administrative Tribunal. Should that be the case, the matter will be reported to the Assembly in accordance with rule 153 of its rules of procedure;

(i) Item 142, “International Civil Service Commission, seventy-third session”. In section I, paragraph 4 (g) of its resolution 40/243, the General Assembly reaffirmed that the Commission should hold its regular annual session at United Nations Headquarters and, if more than one session is required in any one year, may accept an invitation from one of its participating organizations to hold its other session or sessions at the headquarters of that particular organization. It is anticipated that the Commission will hold its fall 2011 session at the headquarters of one of the participating organizations so as to enable the members to familiarize themselves with conditions at other duty stations and to establish contacts with members of legislative bodies of other organizations;

(j) Item 293, “United Nations Appeals Tribunal” and item 294, “United Nations Dispute Tribunal”. Please refer to subparagraph (h) above;

(k) The Committee may recall that the General Assembly, in its resolution 62/218, decided to authorize the Committee on the Elimination of Discrimination against Women to hold three annual sessions of three weeks each, with a one-week pre-sessional working group for each session, for an interim period effective from January 2010, pending the entry into force of the amendment to article 20, paragraph 1, of the Convention, and to authorize three annual sessions of the Working Group on Communications under the Optional Protocol to the Convention. The amendment to article 20 had not yet entered into force at the time of the preparation of the present draft calendar. For planning purposes, the pattern of meetings of the Committee, its pre-sessional working group and the Working Group on Communications for 2010 and 2011 is reflected in the present document in accordance with the above authorization by the Assembly pending the possible entry into force of the amendment during the 2010-2011 biennium;

(l) The Committee may wish to be informed that the United Nations Group of Experts on Geographical Names, which is based in New York, is considering holding its twenty-sixth session, to be held in 2011, away from its headquarters in one of the other United Nations duty stations, subject to approval by the Economic and Social Council;

(m) The Committee may wish to recall that in paragraphs 4 and 5 of its resolution 63/227, the General Assembly decided to convene the Fourth United Nations Conference on the Least Developed Countries at a high level in 2011 for a duration of not more than five working days and also decided to convene, towards the end of 2010 and/or early in 2011, an intergovernmental preparatory committee, which would hold no more than two meetings. In paragraph 7 of the same resolution, the Assembly stressed that the Conference and the preparatory activities should be carried out within the budget level proposed by the Secretary-General for the biennium 2010-2011 and should be organized in the most effective and efficient manner possible. It is the understanding of the Department for General Assembly and Conference Management that the Conference and its preparatory committee will be held in New York in accordance with the headquarters rule specified in paragraph 4 of Assembly resolution 40/243. The Department will absorb the costs for the provision of conference services in New York if the dates of the Conference and its preparatory committee are decided in consultation with the Department and will entail not more than two meetings per day, one in the morning and one in the afternoon, for a duration of five days and two days, respectively. However, if the

services required for the Conference and its preparatory committee exceed the above understanding, the matter will be reported to the Assembly in accordance with rule 153 of its rules of procedure. If the Conference and its preparatory committee are held away from New York Headquarters, the provisions of paragraph 5 of Assembly resolution 40/243 will apply.

5. In its resolution 53/208 A, the General Assembly decided that United Nations bodies should be invited to avoid holding meetings on Orthodox Good Friday and that that arrangement should be taken into account when drafting future calendars of conferences and meetings. For the next biennium, Orthodox Good Friday falls on 2 April 2010 and 22 April 2011.
