An Act to amend the Misuse of Drugs Act, 1973 (21 of 1973)

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Antigua, and by the authority of the same as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Misuse of Drugs (Amendment) Act, 1975.

2. The Misuse of Drugs Act, 1973 is hereby amended in section 4 by the addition, immediately following subsection (2) thereof, of the following new subsection:

Short title.

Amendment of Act No. 21 of 1973. "(3) Any person who imports or exports controlled drugs contrary to subsection (1) shall be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction therefor to the penalties laid down in section 27 of this Act.".
