Financial implications of the draft resolution adopted by the Fourth Committee (A/3733, Graft resolution III)

Report of the Fifth Committee

1. Pursuant to rule 154 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, the Fifth Committee, at its 624th meeting, considered the financial implications of a draft resolution adopted by the Fourth Committee (A/3733, draft resolution III) on the basis of a note by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/729) and a report thereon by the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions (A/3734).

2. The Fifth Committee decided, by 48 votes to none, with 10 abstentions, to inform the General Assembly that, though the committee to be established under the draft resolution would add to the conference servicing workload for 1958, it did not appear on the basis of information currently available that the adoption by the Assembly of the draft resolution in question would involve additional appropriations for 1958.
