MINISTERIAL DECREE No. 215/81

The Minister of Public Health,

Noting some printing errors in the English copy of the narcotic table annexed to the Ministerial Decree No. 148/79, 1/

Further to the letter No. LM/S-55 dated 14.5.1981 by the Secretary of the Narcotic Committee,

And in the light of the Undersecretary's data, hereby decides:

Article 1. The following two substances previously omitted shall be added as Nos. 83, and 84, to the English copy of the narcotic table annexed to the Ministerial Decree No. 148/79.

- 83 - Piminodine
- 84 - Piritramide

Article 2. The name of the narcotic substance listed as No. 34 on page 2 of the above mentioned table shall be amended to read as follows:

- 34 - Drotebanol

Article 3. This decree shall be circulated to all those concerned with its implementation and shall come into force on the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.
