LETTER DATED 26 APRIL 1991 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES A.I.
OF THE PERMANENT MISSION OF SPAIN TO THE UNITED NATIONS
ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

In reply to the letter which you addressed on 23 January 1991 to the Minister for Foreign Affairs concerning measures taken by Spain vis-à-vis the countries affected by the Gulf crisis, I have the honour to provide you with the following information on a provisional basis, pending a more comprehensive report by the Spanish authorities:

I. MULTILATERAL ASSISTANCE

1. Under the EEC budget

- An 8 per cent share of assistance totalling 500 million écus (Egypt: 175 million écus; Turkey: 175 million écus; Jordan: 150 million écus)
- An 8 per cent share of the humanitarian assistance to Egypt, Turkey and Jordan: 58 million écus

2. Through other multilateral organizations and agencies (FAO, UNRWA, WHO, inter alia), the exact amount of which has not yet been established.

II. BILATERAL ASSISTANCE
