**SUMMARY STATEMENT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON MATTERS OF
WHICH THE SECURITY COUNCIL IS SEIZED AND ON THE STAGE
REACHED IN THEIR CONSIDERATION**

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following **summary** statement.

The list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in documents S/22110 of 28 January 1991, S/22110/Add.3 of 1 February 1991 and S/22110/Add.13 of 25 April 1991.

During the week ending 13 April 1991, the Security Council took action on the following item:

The situation between Iraq and Kuwait (see S/21100/Add.30, S/21100/Add.31, S/21100/Add.32, S/21100/Add.33, S/21100/Add.36, S/21100/Add.37, S/21100/Add.38, S/21100/Add.42, S/21100/Add.43, S/21100/Add.47, S/22110/Add.6, S/22110/Add.7, S/22110/Add.8, S/22110/Add.9 and S/22110/Add.13)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the **item at its** 2983rd meeting, held on 9 April 1991, in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations, having before it the report of the Secretary-General on the implementation of paragraph 5 of Security Council resolution 687 (1991) (S/22454 and Add.1-3).

The President, with the consent of the Council, **invited** the representatives of Iraq and Kuwait, at their request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

The President drew attention to the text of a draft resolution contained in document S/22470 **that** had been prepared in the **course of** the Council's prior consultations and to the fact that the words "Acting under Chapter VII of the Charter of **the** United Nations" **had** been added to the provisional text of draft resolution S/22470 as its second preambular paragraph.

The Security Council then proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/22470, and adopted it unanimously as resolution 689 (1991).

Resolution 689 (1991) reads as follows:

The Security Council,

Recalling its resolution 687 (1991),

Acting under Chapter VII of 'he Charter of the United Nations,

1. Approves the report of the **Secretary-General** on the implementation of **paragraph** 5 of Security Council resolution 687 (1991) contained in document S/22454 and Add.1-3 of 5 and 9 April 1991, respectively;
2. Notes that the **decision to set** up the observer unit was taken in paragraph 5 of resolution 687 (1991) and can only be terminated by a decision of **the** Council: the Council shall therefore review the **question** of termination or continuation every six months;
3. Decides that the modalities for the initial six-month period of the United Nations Iraq-Kuwait Observation **Mission** shall be in accordance with the above-mentioned report and shall also be reviewed every six months.
