### NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

1. At the 99th plenary meeting of its fortieth session, on 2 December 1985, the General Assembly adopted resolution **40/56**, entitled "Twenty-fifth anniversary of the Declaration on the Granting of Independence to Colonial Countries and Peoples". 1/

2. In paragraph 20 of that resolution, the General Assembly

"Invites the Security Council to continue to give special attention to the situation in and around Namibia and to consider imposing mandatory sanctions against South Africa under Chapter VII of the **Charter**".
