Report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Soeprapto HERIJANTO (Indonesia)

1. At its 3rd meeting, on 20 September 1986, the General Assembly decided, on the recommendation of the General Committee, to include in the agenda of its forty-first session, and to allocate to the Fifth Committee, the item entitled:

"Administrative and budgetary co-ordination of the United Nations with the specialized agencies and the International Atomic Energy Agency:

"(a) Report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions;

"(b) Effective administrative and budgetary co-ordination within the framework of the United Nations system: report of the Secretary-General;

"(c) Feasibility of establishing a single administrative tribunal: report of the Secretary-General".

2. At its 24th meeting, on 12 November 1986, on the proposal of the Chairman, the Fifth Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly that it defer until its forty-second session consideration of the item.

RECOMMENDATION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee recommends that the General Assembly defer until its forty-second session consideration of the agenda item entitled "Administrative and budgetary co-ordination of the United Nations with the specialized agencies and the International Atomic Energy Agency".
