Bulgaria: amendments to draft resolution

1. First preambular paragraph:

(a) Insert full employment after higher standard of living

(b) Add as proclaimed in the Charter of the United Nations, the International Covenants on Human Rights, the Declaration on Social Progress and Development, and other basic international instruments in the field of human rights

2. Second preambular paragraph:

After the Universal Declaration of Human Rights add and the International Covenants

3. Insert a new paragraph after the existing third preambular paragraph.

Convinced that man can achieve complete fulfilment of his aspirations only within a just social order and that it is consequently of cardinal importance to accelerate social and economic progress everywhere, thus contributing to international peace and solidarity,

4. Old preambular paragraph 4:

For the full enjoyment by the individuals of the right to own property is necessary read the full enjoyment of equal rights to property for all and equitable distribution of wealth among all members of society, as well as the establishment of the New International Economic Order are necessary

5. Insert the following new preambular paragraph after old preambular paragraph 4:

Convinced that ensuring equal rights to property for all is necessary for fostering economic and social progress and development,

6. Operative paragraph 3:

(a) Replace the first sentence by the following:

3. Invites Member States to communicate to the Secretary-General their views on:

(b) Replace the last sentence by a separate new operative paragraph 4, to read as follows:

4. Requests the Secretary-General to report on the issue to the General Assembly at its forty-second session.
