Note by the Secretary-General

Addendum

1. Further to the notification submitted to the General Assembly on 17 September 1986 (A/41/613), the Secretary-General has the honour to notify the Assembly of additional matters relative to the maintenance of international peace and security that are being dealt with by the Security Council, and of a matter with which the Council has ceased to deal.
2. Two additional matters that have been taken under consideration by the Security Council since the notification to the General Assembly on 17 September are: "Letter dated 17 October 1986 from the Permanent Representative of Nicaragua to the United Nations addressed to the President of the Security Council" and "Letter dated 13 November 1986 from the Permanent Representative of Chad to the United Nations addressed to the President of the Security Council".
3. During this period, one item listed in the notification submitted to the General Assembly on 17 September 1986 (A/41/613) and in previous notifications was deleted from the list, pursuant to the request contained in a letter dated 13 November 1986 from the Permanent Representatives of Iceland and the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland. The Secretary-General, with the consent of the Security Council, therefore removed the following item (item 68) from the list: "Letter dated 12 December 1975 from the Permanent Representative of Iceland to the United Nations addressed to the President of the Security Council".
