NOTE VERBALE DATED 31 JULY 1991 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE  
OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE  
SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Representative of the Czech and Slovak Federal Republic to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, with reference to his rote of 3 July 1991, has the honour to inform the Secretary-General of the following:

In connection with commercial relations with Iraq, the decree of the Czech and Slovak Federal Ministry of Foreign Trade on the prohibition against trade with Iraq is still in effect. The granting of an exception to this prohibition is possible only in accordance with the provisions of Security Council resolution 687 (1991) for the export of foodstuff or other commodities for humanitarian purposes.

All exports of arms matériel from the Czech and Slovak Federal Republic are subject to a licence arrangement. In accordance with the above-mentioned decree, the competent Czechoslovak authorities will not issue a licence that is contradictory to the guidelines to facilitate full international implementation of paragraphs 24, 25 and 27 of Security Council resolution 687 (1991) approved by the Security Council in resolution 700 (1991).
