NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

1. At the 94th plenary meeting of its forty-first session, on 3 December 1986, the General Assembly adopted resolution 41/55, entitled "Implementation of the Declaration on the Denuclearization of Africa". 1/

2. In paragraph 9 of resolution 41/55 B, the General Assembly:

"Requests the Security Council to conclude expeditiously its consideration of the recommendations of its Committee established by resolution 421 (1977) concerning the question of South Africa, 2/ with a view to blocking the existing loopholes in the arms embargo so as to render it more effective and prohibiting, in particular, all forms of co-operation and collaboration with the racist régime of South Africa in the nuclear field;".
