NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

1. At the 97th **plenary meeting** of its forty-first session, on 4 December 1986, the General **Assembly** adopted resolution **41/162**, entitled "**The situation in the Middle East**". 1/

2. In paragraphs 13 and **14** of resolution **41/162 A**, the General **Assembly**:

"13. Reaffirms its call for the convening of the International **Peace Conference** on the Middle **East**, under the **auspices** of the United Nations and on the **basis** of its relevant resolutions, **as** specified in paragraph **5** of the Geneva Declaration on Palestine 2/ and endorsed **by** the General Assembly in its resolution **38/58 C** of 13 **December 1983**;

"14. Endorses the call for setting up a **preparatory** committee, within the framework of the Security Council, with the participation of the Permanent members of the Council, to take the necessary action to convene the **Conference**";.
