AGENDA ITEM 51

Consolidation of the Special Fund and the Expanded Programme of Technical Assistance in a United Nations Development Programme (*continued*) (A/5755, A/6015; A/C.2/L.792, L.793, L.795 and Corr.1 and 3 and Add.1)

1. The CHAIRMAN suggested that the sponsors of the various amendments to the draft resolution (A/C.2/L.792) should hold informal talks in an effort to reach agreement.

*It was so agreed.*

2. After a brief procedural discussion in which Mr. PARDO (Malta), Mr. ENDESHAW (Ethiopia), Mr. NEDIVI (Israel), Mr. ARKADYEV (Union of Soviet Socialist Republics), Mr. CHAMMAS (Lebanon) and Mr. TELL (Jordan) took part, the CHAIRMAN suggested that, as agreement had not yet been reached, the sponsors of the amendments should hold further informal talks and that the Committee should meet the following afternoon when those representatives who wished to do so could explain their amendments.
