APPLICATION OF BARBADOS FOR ADMISSION TO MEMBERSHIP
IN THE UNITED NATIONS

Letter dated 30 November 1966 from the Prime Minister
of Barbados to the Secretary-General

Note by the Secretary-General: Pursuant to rule 136 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, the Secretary-General has the honour to submit herewith, for the information of the Members of the United Nations, a copy of a letter dated 30 November 1966 from the Prime Minister of Barbados concerning the admission of Barbados to membership in the United Nations.

On behalf of the Government of Barbados and in my capacity as Prime Minister, I have the honour to inform you that Barbados, having today attained independence, wishes herewith to make application for membership of the United Nations with all the rights and duties attached thereto.

I should accordingly be grateful if this application could be submitted to the Security Council at its next meeting. For this purpose I attach a declaration made in pursuance of rule 58 of the Council's rules of procedure.
