The first two sections provide a review of the theme's *background* along with related *resolutions and international declarations*.


A compilation of important *standards and methods* including pertinent *reports and meetings* are available and can be downloaded for free.

News and media tools related to global, regional and national events are also updated regularly.


Links, networks and contact information for main users, producers and focal points in each area are available to facilitate networking.
