In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 23 of the Dangerous Drugs Act, 1930 (II of 1930), the Raj Pramukh is pleased to authorize the undermentioned officers of the Excise, Police and Revenue Departments to exercise the powers enumerated in the said sub-section:

Excise Department.

Assistant Commissioner of Excise, District Excise Officer, Assistant District Excise Officers, Inspectors and Sub-Inspectors.

Police Department.

District Superintendents, Deputy Superintendents, Inspectors, Sub-Inspectors and Head Constables.

Revenue Department.

Collectors, Tahsildars and Naib-Tahsildars.

Opium Department.

Administrative Officer not lower in rank to a Girdawar or Supervisor.
