**NOTIFICATION  
OPIUM.**

No. 1. In pursuance of rule 2 of the Central Opium Rules, 1934, read with section 5 of the Dangerous Drugs Act, 1930 (II of 1930), the Central Government is pleased to permit during the year 1953-54 the cultivation of poppy by licensed cultivators on account of the Government in the undermentioned tracts of the North West Frontier Province and the Punjab namely:-

- 1- Mardan and Swabi Tehsils of the District of Mardan.
- 2- Charsadda, Nowshera and Peshawar Tehsils of the District of Peshawar.
- 3- Haripur Tehsil of the District of Hazara.
- 4- Attock Tehsil of the District of Campbellpur.

No. D. 573-B/54-- In pursuance of the provisions of sub-section (3) of section 95 of the

Government of India Act, 1935 (26 Geo. 5, Ch. 2), the Governor-General is pleased to promulgate the following Regulation which has been made by him in exercise of the powers conferred by the said sub-section:-

**REGULATION No. I of 1954**

**A Regulation to amend the law relating to Opium Smoking in Baluchistan.**

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Baluchistan Opium Smoking Regulation, 1950, for the purpose hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows:-

1. Title and commencement-- (1) This Regulation may be called the Baluchistan Opium Smoking (Amendment) Regulation, 1954.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. Amendment of section 3 of the Schedule to the Baluchistan Opium Smoking Regulation, 1950-- In section 3 of the Schedule to the Baluchistan Opium Smoking Regulation, 1950:-

(a) in sub-section (1), for the figure, brackets and words "(1) Except as hereinafter provided any person" the words "Any person" shall be substituted; and

(b) sub-section (2), shall be omitted.
