In accordance with Article 21 of the Convention of 13 July 1931 for Limiting the Manufacture and Regulating the Distribution of Narcotic Drugs, as amended by the Protocol of 11 December 1946, the Secretary-General has the honour to communicate the following legislative text.

DECREE

CONCERNING THE DECLARATION OF NEW PREPARATIONS AS NARCOTIC DRUGS

1. The following preparations which are capable of inducing drug addiction shall also be considered as narcotic drugs within the meaning of the Law on Narcotic Drugs (Official Gazette of the FPRY, No. 16, 1950.):

- 4 - (3-hydroxyphenyl) - 1-methyl - 4-piperidyl ethyl ketone hydrochloride;
- 1 - methyl - 4-metahydroxyphenyl - piperidine - 4-carboxylic acid ethyl ester;
- a - 1,3-dimethyl - 4-phenyl - 4-propionoxy piperidine;
- b - 1,3-dimethyl - 4-phenyl - 4-propionoxy piperidine;
- 4,4-diphenyl - 5-methyl - 6-dimethylamine-hexanone-3;
- 6 - dimethylamino - 4,4-diphenyl - 3-heptanol;
- 6 - dimethylamino - 4,4-diphenyl - 3-acetoxyheptane;
- 6 - morpholino - 4,4-diphenyl - 3-heptanone;
- 1 - methyl - 3-ethyl - 4-phenyl - 4-propionoxy piperidine;
- 3 - hydroxy-N-methyl morphinan.

2. This decree shall come into force on the day of its promulgation in the "Official Gazette of the Federal People's Republic of Yugoslavia".
