## I. Introduction

1. The present addendum provides information about the status of implementation of recommendations issued by the Office of Internal Oversight Services. The report includes an overall assessment of the implementation of recommendations (sect. II), an analysis of open recommendations, broken down by entity (sect. III), a list of critical recommendations the implementation of which is past due (sect. IV), recommendations with financial implications (sect. V) and a list of all of the oversight reports issued between 1 July 2016 and 30 June 2017 (sect. VI).


## II. Overall assessment of the implementation of recommendations




2. A breakdown of the status of implementation of recommendations issued by OIOS from 1 January 2013 to 31 December 2016, including the implementation rate for each of those calendar years, is provided in the figure below.<sup>1</sup> In 2016, OIOS issued 1,153 recommendations to United Nations entities. Of those, 48 (4 per cent) were deemed critical. As at 31 December 2016, programme managers had implemented 624 (56 per cent) of the recommendations issued during the calendar year, including 39 (81 per cent) of the critical recommendations issued during 2016.

<sup>1</sup> The most recent follow-up of important recommendations was carried out in February 2017 for recommendations issued by 31 December 2016, in accordance with the new follow-up schedule established in 2011 (see [A/67/297](#) (Part I)). Critical recommendations due for implementation are followed up on a quarterly basis; therefore their status is as at 30 June 2017 in the case of recommendations issued up to the end of 2016. The information in the figure is provided by calendar year to ensure compatibility with past calendar years and to ensure consistency with the performance data used in the senior managers' compacts.


**Status of recommendations issued from 1 January 2013 to 31 December 2016 as at 28 February 2017, and implementation rates<sup>a</sup>**

<sup>a</sup> A recommendation may be closed when, for example, it is overtaken by events or when management accepts responsibility for residual risk arising from the non-implementation of the recommendation. It is to be noted that the rates of implementation of recommendations are based on the total number of implemented recommendations divided by the number of recommendations issued, excluding those that have been closed. These figures exclude declined recommendations.

**III. Analysis of open recommendations**

3. Information about the status of all outstanding recommendations issued up to the end of 30 June 2017 for each United Nations department/office is provided in table 1. Of the 1,287 open recommendations issued as at 30 June 2017, 24 critical recommendations (2 per cent) were outstanding, 17 of them had missed the target date and 7 of them were not yet due. Specific information on critical recommendations for which implementation is overdue, including management's response, is provided in section IV.

## V. Financial implications of recommendations

5. A summary of OIOS recommendations with financial implications is provided in table 3. OIOS classifies financial implications according to several categories, including loss and waste of resources, recovery, expenditure reduction, additional income and budget reduction.

6. During the reporting period, OIOS identified \$16 million in potential recoveries and expenditure reduction, of which a total of \$5 million was realized during that period.
