ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA OF THE TWENTY-FIFTH REGULAR SESSION
AND ALLOCATION OF ITEMS

Second report of the General Committee

1. At its 189th meeting, on 5 October 1970, the General Committee considered a request submitted by Belgium, Brazil, Costa Rica, Ecuador, Indonesia, Japan, Laos, Luxembourg, Nepal, the Netherlands, Panama, Peru, the Philippines and Thailand (A/8091) for the inclusion in the agenda of the twenty-fifth session of a new item entitled "Aerial hijacking or interference with civil air travel".^{1/} The General Committee decided to recommend that the item should be included in the agenda and allocated to the Sixth Committee.
2. At the same meeting, the General Committee considered a request submitted by the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland (A/8092) for the inclusion in the agenda of an additional item entitled "Admission of new Members to the United Nations". The General Committee decided to recommend that the item should be included in the agenda and allocated directly to plenary meetings.
