UNITED NATIONS TELECOMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM

Resolution adopted by the General Assembly at its
320th plenary meeting on 12 December 1950

(adopted on the report of the Fifth Committee (A/1635))

The General Assembly

1. Instructs the Secretary-General to proceed with the implementation of the proposals outlined in document A/1454 for a modified United Nations telecommunications system, provided that the capital expenditure involved does not constitute a net addition to the budget of the United Nations;
2. Authorizes the Secretary-General to accept for this purpose such voluntary contributions and/or donations as would be appropriate and necessary to carry out these proposals in whole or in part, it being understood that any and all facilities or funds made available to the United Nations as a result of such voluntary gifts or contributions would become exclusive property and be under the sole control of the United Nations;
3. Requests the Secretary-General to report on this matter to the sixth session of the General Assembly.
