Note verbale dated 12 December 1956 from the Permanent Mission of Hungary
to the United Nations, addressed to the Secretary-General

New York, 12 December 1956

The Permanent Mission of the Hungarian People's Republic to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, upon instructions from its Government, has the honour to inform him of the following:

The Hungarian Government refers to its previous statements which express its willingness to conduct negotiations with the Secretary-General of the United Nations. It refers also to the fact that on 3 December it informed the Secretary-General of the United Nations of its willingness to receive him in Budapest at a later date appropriate for both parties. The Hungarian Government states also that 16 December, which has been designated by the Secretary-General of the United Nations as a date for his visit to Budapest, is not appropriate for the Hungarian Government. On the other hand, the Hungarian Government will, at a later date, set forth a proposal through its representatives in New York for the purpose of reaching an agreement on the visit of the Secretary-General of the United Nations.
