ORGANIZATION OF AN INTERNATIONAL PRESS  
CONFERENCE

REPORT OF THE GENERAL COMMITTEE TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

At its twelfth meeting held on 7 February, 1946, the General Committee considered the Draft Resolution of the Delegation of the Philippine Commonwealth concerning the calling of an international press conference (A/BUR/24).

The Philippine Delegation had, at the beginning of the session, requested the inclusion of an item to this effect on the supplementary list. In its report on the supplementary list (A/BUR/6), the General Committee stated that the proposal, while of great interest, was couched in too general terms for the Committee to reach an immediate decision. The Philippine Delegation was therefore requested to submit further details, with the object of providing the General Committee with material upon which to base a recommendation whether the proposal should be placed on the provisional agenda for the second part of the first session of the General Assembly. The Draft Resolution had accordingly been submitted by the Philippine Delegation in response to this request.

The General Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following resolution :

THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTS THE SECRETARY-GENERAL to place the question of the organization of an international press conference upon the agenda of the second part of the first session of the General Assembly.
