Decides to broaden the membership of the Ten-Nation Disarmament Committee to include, in addition to the representatives of Bulgaria, Canada, Czechoslovakia, France, Italy, Poland, Romania, the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the United States of America, representatives of the following countries: India, Indonesia, the United Arab Republic, Ghana and Mexico.
