DRAFT INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON THE ELIMINATION OF ALL
FORMS OF RACIAL DISCRIMINATION

Canada: amendment to the articles submitted by Ghana,
Mauritania and Philippines (A/C.3/L.1291) relating to
measures of implementation to be added to the provisions
of the draft International Convention on the Elimination
of All Forms of Racial Discrimination adopted by the
Commission on Human Rights (A/5921, annex)

Replace paragraph 1 (a) of article XI by the following:

1. (a) After the Committee has obtained and collated all the information it thinks necessary, the Chairman shall appoint an ad hoc Conciliation Commission (hereinafter referred to as the Commission) comprising five persons who may or may not be members of the Committee. The members of the Commission shall be appointed with the full and unanimous consent of the parties to the dispute, and its good offices shall be made available to the States concerned with a view to an amicable solution of the matter on the basis of respect for the Convention.
