APPOINTMENTS TO FILL VACANCIES IN THE MEMBERSHIP  
OF SUBSIDIARY BODIES OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

UNITED NATIONS STAFF PENSION COMMITTEE

Note by the Secretary-General

1. At its twenty-second and twenty-fourth sessions, the General Assembly by resolutions 2303 (XXII) of 13 December 1967 and 2523 (XXIV) of 5 December 1969, appointed the following persons, for terms of office ending on 31 December 1970, as members and alternate members of the United Nations Staff Pension Committee:

Members:

Mr. Albert F. Bender (United States of America);  
Mr. John I.M. Rhodes (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland);  
Mr. Guillermo Valdés (Chile).

Alternate members:

Mr. Alfred J. Cahen (Belgium);  
Mr. John R. Kelso (Australia);  
Mr. Harry L. Morris (Liberia).

2. Accordingly, it will be necessary for the General Assembly at its twenty-fifth session to elect three members and three alternate members to the Committee to serve for a period of three years, beginning on 1 January 1971.

3. At previous sessions, the Fifth Committee, after a secret ballot, submitted to the General Assembly a draft resolution containing the names of the persons recommended for appointment. It is suggested that a similar procedure be followed at the twenty-fifth session.
