## APPROVAL OF DRAFT AGREEMENTS BY SPECIALIZED AGENCIES

The Secretary-General submits for the information of the General Assembly the notification of approval received from the Provisional International Civil Aviation Organization of the Draft Agreement entered into between the United Nations and the International Civil Aviation Organization:

Sir,

I have the honour to inform you that the Interim Council, at its meeting yesterday, unanimously approved the Draft Agreement with the United Nations, as signed on behalf of the Provisional International Civil Aviation Organization by the Chairman of our Negotiating Committee, Sir James Cotton, on 30 September 1946, and subsequently approved by the Economic and Social Council.

In accordance with Article XXII of the Agreement, this instrument will enter into force after approval by the General Assembly of the United Nations and the Assembly of the International Civil Aviation Organization. It is expected that the Assembly of the International Civil Aviation Organization will be convened on 6 May 1947, at which time the Draft Agreement will be presented to it for final approval. In the meantime, it is understood that the Agreement will be implemented, so far as possible, between the Provisional International Civil Aviation Organization and the United Nations.

On this occasion I should like to express to you my wholehearted satisfaction over the Council's action in approving the Draft Agreement and I hope sincerely that this step will advance our common cause of practical international cooperation.
