1. Calling of General Conference of Members of the United Nations under Article 109 of the Charter in order to eliminate the veto. (Item proposed by Cuba).
2. Statement by the Union of South Africa on the outcome of their consultations with the peoples of South West Africa as to the future status of the mandated territory and implementation to be given to the wishes thus expressed. (Item proposed by the Union of South Africa).
3. Carrying out of provisions of Article 13 of the Charter regarding the progressive development of international law and its codification. (Item proposed by the United States of America).
4. Interpretation of Articles 11 and 12 of the Statute of the International Court of Justice. (Item proposed by the United States of America).
5. Request for an advisory opinion from the International Court of Justice on the meaning of the word "meeting" in Articles 11 and 12 of the Statute of the Court. (Item proposed by the United Kingdom).
