APPOINTMENTS TO FILL VACANCIES IN THE MEMBERSHIP  
OF SUBSIDIARY BODIES OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

UNITED NATIONS STAFF PENSION COMMITTEE

Note by the Secretary-General

1. At its seventh session, the General Assembly, by resolution 671 (VII), appointed the following persons as members and alternate members of the United Nations Staff Pension Committee, in accordance with article XXI of the regulations<sup>1/</sup> for the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Fund:

Members: Mr. Keith G. Brennan (Australia)  
Mr. R.T. Cristobal (Philippines)  
Mr. Francisco A. Forteza (Uruguay)

Alternates: Mr. Arthur H. Clough (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland)  
Mr. Warren B. Irons (United States of America)  
Mr. Fazlollah Nouredin Kea (Iran)

2. At its ninth session, the General Assembly, by resolution 870 (IX), appointed Mr. T.W. Cutts (Australia) to fill a vacancy created by the resignation of Mr. Keith G. Brennan.

3. The terms of office of the above members and alternate members expire on 31 December 1955. Thus it will be necessary for the General Assembly at its tenth session to appoint three members and three alternate members to the United Nations Staff Pension Committee, to serve for a period of three years, commencing 1 January 1956.
