Congo: amendments to the draft resolution contained in
document A/46/23 (Part III), chapter IV, paragraph 12

1. Page 6: replace the eighth preambular paragraph by the following text

Gravely concerned that certain countries, transnational corporations
and international financial institutions have continued their economic
relations with South Africa,

2. Page 6: replace the ninth preambular paragraph by the following text

Recognizing the crucial and decisive role the imposition of
international sanctions has played in applying the necessary pressure on
the South African regime to undertake significant measures towards the
eradication of apartheid,

3. Page 7: replace operative paragraphs 6, 7 and 8 by the following text
(General Assembly resolution 45/176 A, paragraph 13)

6. Calls upon all Governments to observe fully the mandatory arms
embargo and requests the Security Council to monitor effectively the
strict implementation of the arms embargo;

and renumber the succeeding paragraphs accordingly.

4. Page 8: replace the present operative paragraph 16 (new operative paragraph 14) by the following text

14. Appeals to mass media, trade unions and non-governmental organizations, as well as individuals, to continue their efforts to mobilize international public opinion against the relaxation of existing measures against the regime, in order to accelerate the process of constitutional change;
