PERMANENT MISSIONS TO THE UNITED NATIONS

Resolution adopted by the General Assembly at
its 266th plenary meeting on 3 December 1949

(adopted on the report of the Sixth Committee (A/1178))

The General Assembly,

Having examined the Secretary-General's report on permanent missions to the United Nations (A/939/Rev.1 and A/939/Rev.1/Add.1) submitted in compliance with General Assembly resolution 257 (III) A of 3 December 1948,

1. Notes with satisfaction that fifty-one Member States have set up permanent missions at the seat of the United Nations;

2. Invites all Member States which have set up such missions and which have not yet transmitted to the Secretary-General the credentials of their permanent representatives to do so as soon as possible.
