#### COMMISSIONER IN LIBYA

#### Report of the Committee established by the General Assembly on 21 November 1949, to nominate a candidate

In accordance with the terms of resolution B adopted by the General Assembly on 21 November 1949 (A/1124), the Committee composed of Brigadier-General Carlos P. Romulo, President of the General Assembly, Sir Zafrullah Khan, Vice-President, Mr. Freitas Valle, Vice-President, Mr. L. B. Pearson, Chairman of the First Committee, and Mr. Nasrollah Entezam, Chairman of the Ad Hoc Political Committee, has duly nominated a candidate for the office of United Nations Commissioner in Libya.
