VIEW OF RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY POLITICAL COMMITTEE DERIVED EXGENERAL ASSEMBLY UNATIONS CONCERNING INTERNATIONALIZATION OF JERUSALEM, GOVERNMENT OF HASHEMITE KINGDOM OF JORDAN HEREBY DECLARES IT OBJECTS TO ANY MEASURES AND ARRANGEMENTS WHICH MAY BE TAKEN IN THIS REGARD BECAUSE IT BELIEVES THAT SUCH MEASURES AND ARRANGEMENTS ARE HARMFUL TO ITS VITAL INTERESTS AND TO SECURITY OF ITS TERRITORY. JORDAN GOVERNMENT WISHES INFORM GENERAL ASSEMBLY BEFORE FINAL CONSIDERATION OF RESOLUTION OF POLITICAL COMMITTEE THAT IT WILL OPPOSE THE EXECUTION OF WHATEVER IS DECIDED CONTRARY TO ITS RIGHTFUL WISHES WHICH HAVE BEEN CONSISTENTLY EXPOUNDED TO VARIOUS ORGANIZATIONS CONCERNED AND TO WORLD AT LARGE BY JORDAN GOVERNMENT.
